Beginning on February 1st, the application process has officially started to select the next generation of Rotary Peace Fellows who will study at the Rotary Global Peace Centers in 2024. The Rotary Peace Centers program is, at its core, aimed at fostering a positive vision of sustainable peace, peacebuilding and the prevention or resolution of emerging conflicts, worldwide. Overall, the program is implemented in cooperation with leading universities (Duke University; University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, USA; International Christian University, Japan; University of Bradford, England; University of Queensland, Australia; Uppsala University, Sweden), for education, support and strengthening of the capacities of future peacebuilders. Statistical reviews so far show that more than 1600 alums of this program are working on issues related to peace and peacebuilding in more than 140 countries in a global framework. The program creates future leaders in the fields of education and research, governmental and non-governmental sectors, multilateral organizations such as the United Nations and the World Bank, organizations that encourage enforcement of laws, media affirmation during peacebuilding, and the like.
